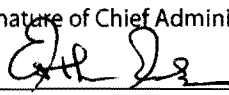

1           A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION  
2           OF THE TOWN OF LAUDERDALE-BY-THE-SEA,  
3           FLORIDA, ADOPTING A PROPOSED MILLAGE  
4           RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING  
5           OCTOBER 1, 2009, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30,  
6           2010; STATING THE PERCENTAGE AMOUNT OF  
7           THE PROPOSED RATE DOES NOT EXCEED THE  
8           ROLLED BACK RATE; ANNOUNCING THE DATE,  
9           TIME AND PLACE OF THE FIRST PUBLIC  
10          HEARING TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSED  
11          MILLAGE RATE AND THE TENTATIVE BUDGET;  
12          PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CONFLICTS,  
13          AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Florida Statute 200.065(2)(b) it is the responsibility of the  
16          Municipality's governing body to advise the Property Appraiser of its roll back millage rate,  
17          proposed millage rate and the date, time and place of the public hearing to consider the  
18          proposed millage rate and tentative budget;

19           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF**  
20          **THE TOWN OF LAUDERDALE BY THE SEA, FLORIDA, THAT:**

21           Section 1.     The Town Commission of the Town of Lauderdale-By-The Sea,  
22          Florida, hereby adopts a proposed millage rate of 3.9990 for Fiscal Year 2009-2010. The  
23          rolled-back rate is 4.4829.

24           Section 2.     The Town Commission of the Town of Lauderdale-By-The Sea Florida,  
25          hereby sets September 14, 2009 at 5:01 P.M., in the Commission Chambers (Jarvis Hall)  
26          located at 4501 Ocean Drive, Lauderdale-By-The Sea, Florida, as the date, time and place of  
27          the public hearing to consider the proposed millage rate and the tentative budget.

28           Section 3.     The Town Manager is hereby authorized to execute and submit DR-420  
29          Certification of Taxable Value to the Broward County Property Appraiser's Office.

30           Section 4.     If any clause, section, or other part of this Resolution shall be held by  
31          any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or  
32          invalid part shall be considered as eliminated and in no way affecting the validity of the other  
33          provisions of this Resolution.
